### Why by a CHPC Volunteer?

✓ CHPC is a club run by volunteers and with only around 80 families who are members, we need everyone to help out in some way or other during the year.

## "Kindness, like a boomerang, always returns"

- ✓ The club needs to generate a certain amount of income to be self-sustaining, and this is done by running rallies/training, badges, shows, fundraising/social events and other activities through the year but they don't run on their own!
- ✓ The things that we need help with are usually able to be done in a specified time or day, so you can plan your volunteering around your busy diary. There are many different ways to help, whatever your skills and whatever time you have available. See below a list of roles we are currently looking to fill.
- ✓ By volunteering to help at events and competitions this enables the club to generate income that funds subsidised rallies and other activities. By helping out you are therefore benefitting your child even if they are not competing in that event.
- ✓ No matter how old you are there is always something to learn when organising events: older members get a chance to make a significant contribution with their experience and knowledge, and younger members and their families can meet older members and find out more about the variety of opportunities the CHPC has to offer, and how to organise things before it becomes their "turn" to take up the reins of running events.



If every Pony Club family provides help for <u>AT LEAST 3 COMPETITIONS/ACTIVITIES</u> during the year(not including Camp), the workload starts to be fairly shared by everyone.
